

# DIFFERENT WAYS TO SHARE STORIES

Use a story you both enjoy reading and retell it from the pictures.

Find an old photo or a picture from a magazine and make up a story about what's happening.

Make up stories about the people you see when you're out walking ... Who are they? What are they doing? Where are they going?

Try doing a drawing together and make up the story of what's happening as you go along.

Make a book by cutting out pictures or photos and sticking them onto card. Encourage your child to tell you the story.

Make up a story and take turns to think of the next line. By adding, "And then ..."

Find a picture book you've never seen before and make up the story.

Tell your child a story about them. You could put them into a story you know or make up a new one with things they've done or are interested in.

Use toys or puppets to act out a story.

Make up a story together about their favourite TV character.
