RE-TELL ROLE PLAY 1

Re-tell the story of the yetis learning to hide outdoors and join in with their hiding practise adventure.

• Let's pretend that we're little yet is learning how to hide, and I can be Mrs Cave-wick from the story. Do you think you would make good yet is?



ACTION PROMPT

We need to practise being yetis ... can you ROAR and make yeti hands?

 Are you ready little yetis? Lets head off towards our first hiding practise at the squelchy bog.



ACTION PROMPT

Make sure to look out for 'people' on the way ... lets tip-toe and creep through the forest so we're not seen.



ACTION PROMPT

Look at this squelchy sticky mud ... it's really thick and gooey. Can you make your paws squelch in the mud like this?



RE-TELL ROLE PLAY 2

 Excellent first try yetis, you managed to hide most of your furry bodies behind the reeds ... but look how muddy you are!



ACTION PROMPT

We'd better shake off some of that gooey mud before we go.



ACTION PROMPT

Let's tip-toe and creep through the forest to the grassy clearing.



ACTION PROMPT

Look at all this long grass little yetis! We're going to have to swish to get through it.

Can you swish through the grass like this?



ACTION PROMPT

Are you ready to <u>crouch down and hide</u> in the grass like the yetis? I'll cover my eyes and we'll count to 10.

 Well done little yetis, you really tried hard, I could only see your furry bottoms sticking up this time.



ACTION PROMPT

We'd better brush off some of those grass seeds that are stuck in your fur before we go...

ACTION PROMPT

Let's tip-toe and creep through the forest to the yeti hiding tree.

RE-TELL ROLE PLAY 3



• Well done little yetis, I can't see you at all!



ACTION PROMPT

Do you remember what the little yet is did when they were in the tree? They were so excited they let out a huge ROAR, will we do the same?

Are you ready to head back to the Nursery?



ACTION PROMPT

Let's climb down the tree, tiptoe and creep through the forest, swish through the long grass and squelch in the boggy mud ...

Back safe and sound, well done little yetis!
